Eastern Mavericks is committed to providing a safe and positive environment for members to play basketball. The Eastern Mavericks Member Protection Officer is responsible for the welfare of all people belonging to our club, especially children. Their role is to help protect members from physical, sexual or emotional abuse while playing for this Club. They are the first point of contact for individuals with a concern, query or complaint in regards to discrimination, harassment and child protection issues. They provide information and options so members can decide how they would like to deal with their matter.

Eastern Mavericks has made a commitment that:

- All Coaches must have a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC) and the agreed Coaching requirements /documentation for Basketball SA Coach Registration.
- All Team Managers must undertake the Play by the Rules Certification and provide a copy of the Certificate to the Administration Officer. This remains valid for 2 years.
- All Team Managers must have a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC) and provide this to the Administration Officer.
- All Team Managers must undertake the Play by the Rules Certification and provide a copy of the Certificate to the Administration Officer. This remains valid for 2 years.
- U14 Teams to Club National Championships- all Parents to undertake the Play by the Rules online <u>child</u> <u>protection</u> and <u>harassment and discrimination</u> trainings.
- All club members are encouraged to complete the Play by the Rules online courses at www.playbytherules.net.au
