JUNIOR PLAYER FINANCIAL COMMITMENT SUBSCRIPTION POLICY 2018/2019

This policy outlines the financial responsibilities and commitment for EMDBC members .

The subscription fees for junior players are recommended by the Committee prior to the start of the summer season. The fees cover the cost of team nomination in the Basketball SA District competition, the payment of court hire for training sessions, Basketball Australia registration charge and Club administration charge.

An invoice is provided to players at the start of the summer season noting a due date for payment, generally within one month of the start of the season. New players joining the club part way through the season will pay a pro-rata fee.

In exceptional circumstances, should you not be in a position to pay the full amount of the fees by the due date, please contact the Treasurer to discuss options for alternative payment arrangements. Fees are non-refundable, except in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the club.

Players who do not meet payment deadlines by the due date, or who have not made alternative payment arrangements with the Club, will become **ineligible for selection beyond the due date**. Furthermore, players who have outstanding membership fees will not be granted a clearance, or be able to register with another club until all financial obligations to the Club are met.

Coaches and Managers will be informed of this policy to assist with its enforcement. To be successful in any sport everyone needs to buy in and be part of the team or organisation - being a financial member makes you part of that team.

The club supports and encourages participation in tournaments. For many, playing tournament basketball is the highlight and is important in terms of player development.
